

INDIGITIZATION MOVEMENT

- 1. Decolonizing ArchiveS uprooting traditional archiving practices and the settler-colonial epistemologies that support them ex. Yale Indian Papers Project.
- 2. Digital Repatriation libraries, museums and other heritage institutions create electronic surrogates of items that are then theoretically available to the source communities that created them ex. Gibagadinamaagoom.
- 3. Cultural Relevance Clarifying and establishing standards with practices that are culturally sustaining while contributing to the project of nation building. Thus, is deeply connected to issues of sovereignty.



Cherole Indian Agency, Cherokee, North Caroline, July 14, 1934. The Commissioner of Indian Affairs. Washington, D. C. Deer Sir: Referring to the last paregraph of your letter of June 20, 1934, I am sending you herewith a bill of meterial for the Snowbird School, with the exception of the heating end plumbing. CLOSE mate of the whole cost of the project, including heating and plumbing, amounts to the following: Material, \$6,117.00 Lubor, 2,328.00 Total. \$8,445.00 This does not include the employees quarters. We have to edd to this for the purchase of land the sum of \$150.00 and for the purchase of the present building from the county, \$500.00. Yours truly,











